1. [Sign up for Diploma Preparation courses](#) (These courses are FREE, plus they include lunch and transportation to Fort Macleod if you need it!)
2. Prepare for summer jobs, volunteer opportunities or summer school.
3. Sign up for any [DUAL CREDIT courses](#) of interest (current grade 9, 10, and 11 students!). NOTE: Dual credit means you gain 5 high school credits as well as 3 post-secondary credits at the same time! When you start college or university, you could already have one or two of your courses completed and have an easier time adjusting to life on your own as a post-secondary student. Plus, tuition is FREE for high school students! It's a no-brainer, really.
