Funds raised directly support athletics at Livingstone School so that ALL students have the opportunity to play.

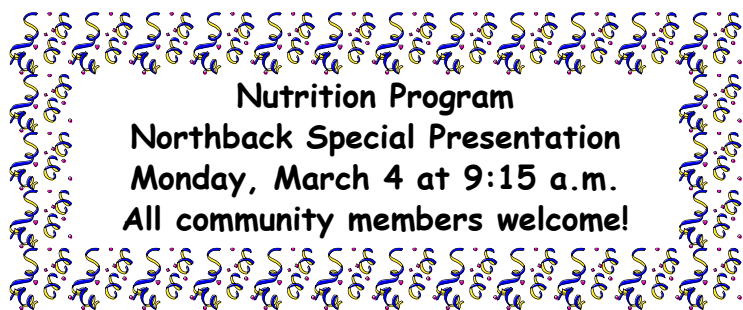
